## Impact Through Targeted Philanthropy

The creation of the PFCU Foundation enables a more focused, program level approach to community support—supplementing, and often enhancing, traditional event sponsorship opportunities. Through this structure, the Foundation ensures resources are directed toward initiatives that align with PFCU's mission and generate lasting, measurable change.

In its inaugural year, the Foundation completed two full grant cycles, awarding **\$38,925** to 22 community initiatives. These investments contributed to positive, tangible improvements throughout the region and established a strong foundation for future philanthropic growth.
